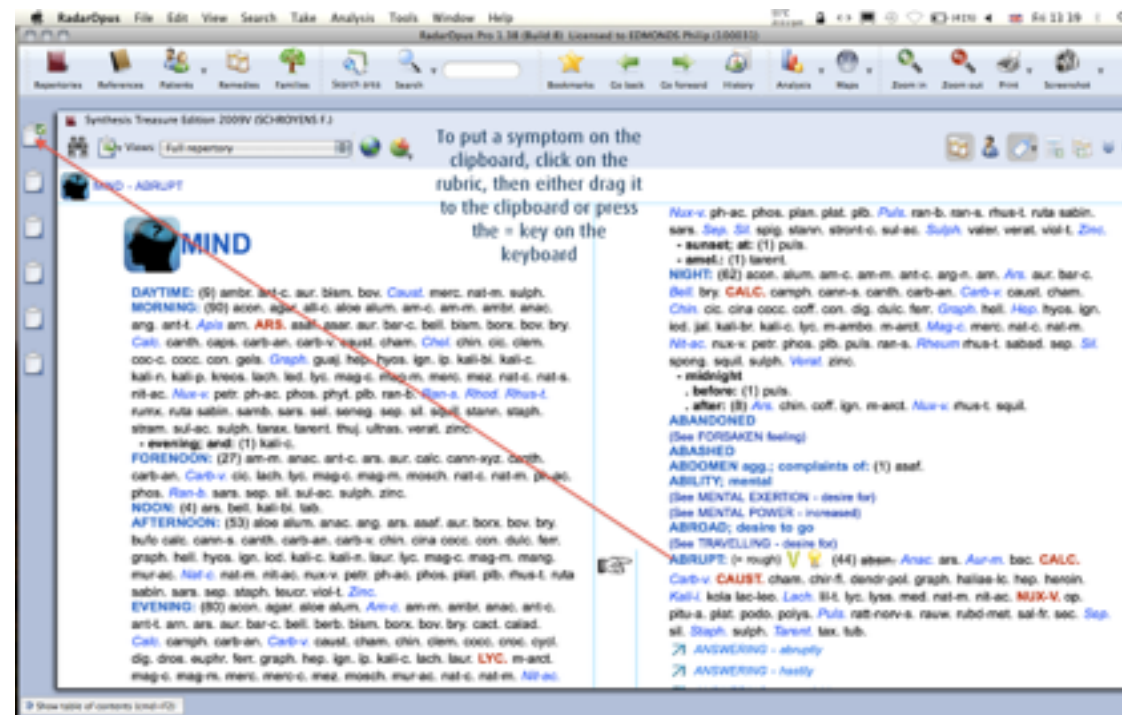

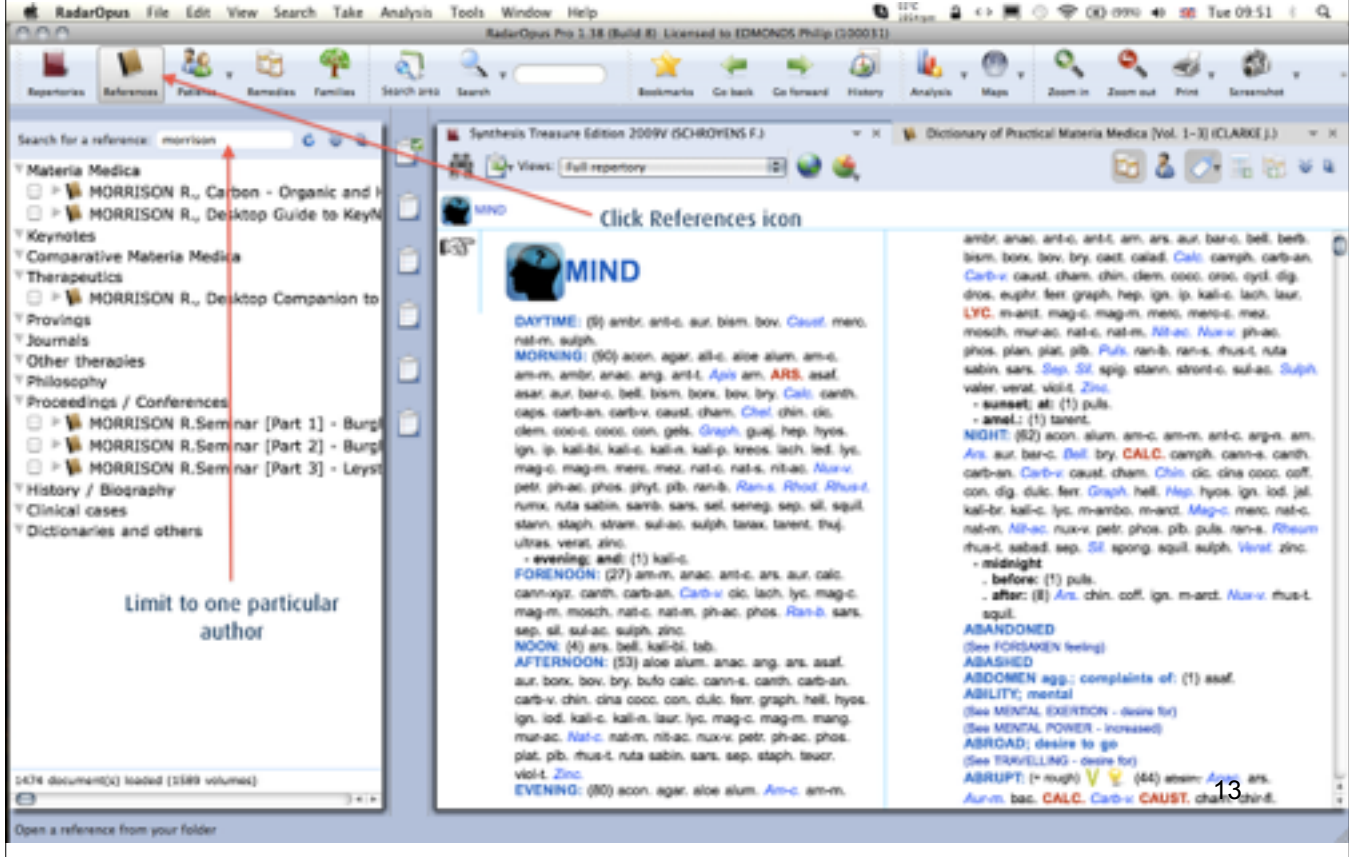

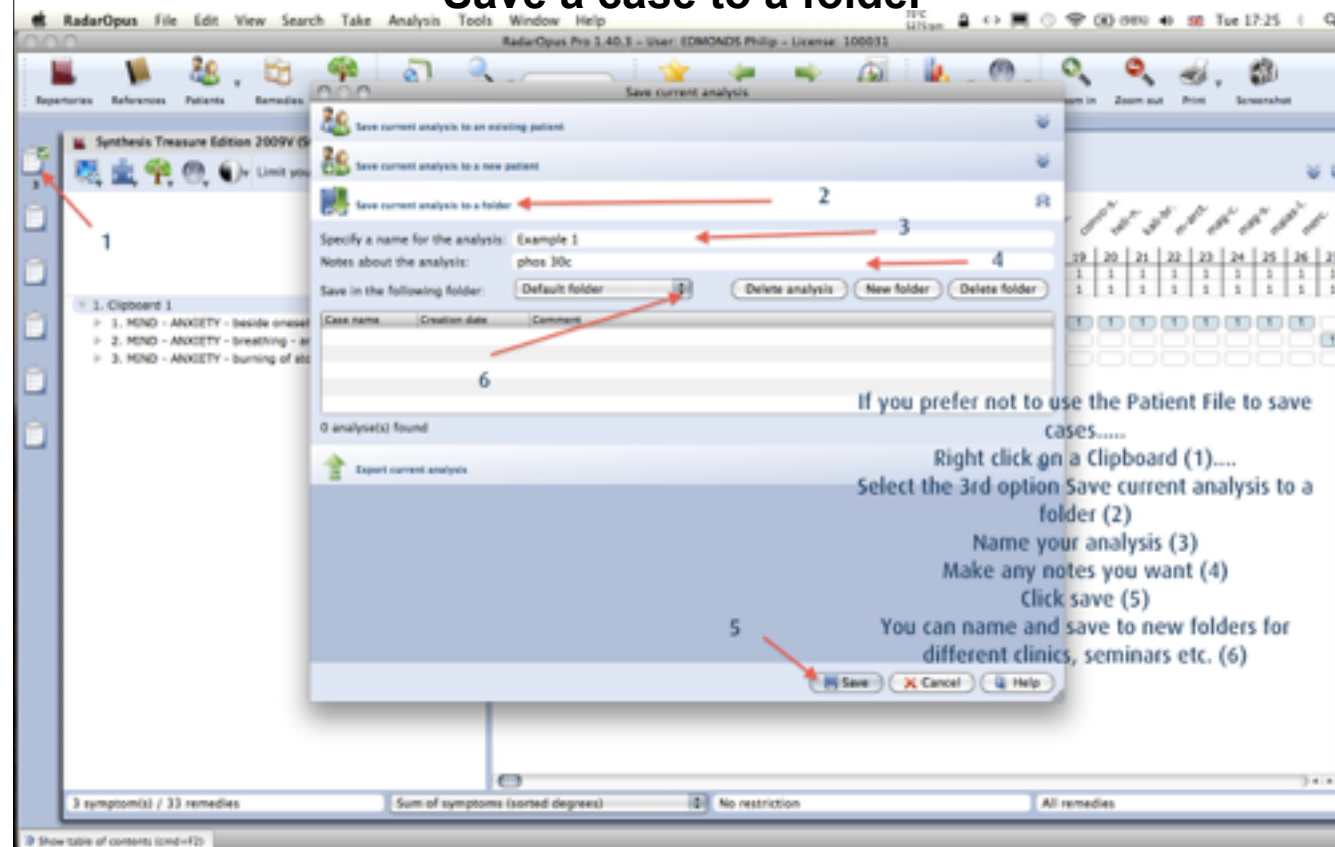

App. **darkness** - do not like **darkness** - **fear** will not wake up again. Feel as if suffocating from **darkness** - have to open window (Lachesis, Grindelia).

At this stage, it can be easy to confuse Calc. carb. with Phosphorus. If the patient retains the typical thirst for cold drinks, the desire for ice cream, and the desire for salt, the decision can be quite difficult. The anxiety about health, **fear** of death, and suggestible **fears** of cancer and heart disease can suggest Phosphorus as well as Calc. carb. Calc. carb. can have **fear** of thunderstorms and **fear** of the **dark**. Calc. carb. often had heart palpitations which resemble Phosphorus.

Gradually, the inversion of hyper-active into hypo-active states reaches into the mental/emotional planes. More and more he has forebodings that something terrible is going to happen to him or to his relatives. Slowly, he develops other **fears** as well; **fear** of the **dark**; **fear** of being alone especially at night, and a **fear** of dogs.

Carbo veg. affects the physical level most strongly, but it may affect the emotional level to some degree. There are few anxieties of **fears** of any strength. There is no **fear** of death, which helps to differentiate Carbo veg. from Arsenicum or Phosphorus. It may have some anxiety about health, especially when closing the eyes on bed at night, but not nearly so prominently as in other remedies. Interestingly, Carbo veg. does not have a **fear** of the **dark**, but it is AGGRAVATED by **darkness**; Carbo veg. may have a **fear** of ghost, like Lycopodium. Also, just as Carbo veg. can be ill since the shock of an accident, it also has a characteristic **fear** of accidents.

It is for these reasons that the Kali carb. patient is difficult for the homeopath to treat. Such a patient will stoically tend




